

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA Book Reports

Each trimester you will complete a book report project about a book you have read. For this report, you must choose one of the ideas listed on the following page.

You must do a different report for each trimester.

Choose a project that you will enjoy doing and that shows off your individual talent and learning style.

### **Book Report Project Options:**

- Write a 2+ page report summarizing the novel.
- Write a poem about the book, one character in it, or some other aspect of the book. The poem must be at least 16 lines long, but does not have to rhyme.
- Make a poster that relates to the novel on poster size paper. (12X18 or poster board size) It should also be colorful and neat.
- Create a Power Point presentation about the book. Present the Power Point to the class. (10+ slides minimum)
- Create a board game about your book. Don't forget all of the pieces that are required to play it. Be sure to include a written component addressing the necessary components stated below.
- Write a 2+ page paper comparing and/or contrasting at least two characters in the book.
- Design a new book cover for the book. **(See your teacher for extra directions)**

*All projects must meet the following guidelines:*

### **Project Guidelines and Rubric:**

- Main Characters are clearly identified with at least 3 qualities listed - **25 pts.**
- Setting is fully described, answering where and when the story took place - **20 pts.**
- Conflict and Plot are thoroughly explained, mentioning at least 5 events - **25 pts.**
- No Spelling or Grammar errors - **10 pts.**
- Neatly done, demonstrating careful thought and effort - **10 pts.**
- Title and Author are listed - **5 pts.**
- Your name on the project - **5 pts.**
